AMATEUR DIVISION

American Saddlebred Horse Amateur Futurity of Indiana

ALL ENTRIES MAY BE OWNED BY PROFESSIONAL OR AMATEUR BUT MUST BE SHOWN BY AMATEURS.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

THE THREE DIVISIONS The American Saddlebred Horse Amateur Futurity of Indiana will be shown in three (3) divisions: Weanlings; Yearlings, and Two-Year Olds.

WHAT COLT'S ARE ELIGIBLE All colts shown must be the produce of stallions and mares who have been previously registered by the American Saddlebred Horse Association Registry.

NOMINATION OF SIRE-AMATEUR FUTURITY

HOW TO NOMINATE THE SIRE To nominate a stallion in the Amateur Futurity, it is necessary: (1) That the stallion be registered by the American Saddlebred Horse Association Registry, and (2) that a fee of \$25.00 be paid to the Amateur Futurity on or before May 1st of the year the foal is born.

NOMINATION OF DAM-AMATEUR FUTURITY

HOW TO NOMINATE THE DAM To nominate a mare in the Amateur Futurity, it is necessary: (1) That the mare be registered by the American Saddlebred Horse Association Registry, and, (2) that a fee of \$20.00 be paid to the Amateur Futurity on or before May 1st of the year in which the foal is to be eligible for the Weanling Division of the Amateur Futurity.

THE WEANLING DIVISION- AMATEUR FUTURITY

HOW TO MAKE A WEANLING ELIGIBLE In order to make a foal eligible to show in the Weanling Division of the Amateur Futurity, the following conditions must be complied with: (1) The sire and dam must be nominated in the Amateur Futurity, the year in which the foal is born. (2) One-time fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Amateur Futurity on or before May 1st of the year the foal is born.

HOW SHOWN, The entries in this division shall be shown In Hand.

THE YEARLING DIVISION-AMATEUR FUTURITY

HOW TO KEEP THE YEARLING ELIGIBLE In order to make a colt, filly, or gelding eligible to show in the Yearling Division of the Amateur Futurity, the following conditions must be complied with: (1) The colt, filly, or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling Division of this Amateur Futurity and all conditions and requirements of that Division must have been fulfilled. (2) One-time fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the year following the birth of the foal.

HOW SHOWN, The entries in this division shall be shown In Hand.

THE TWO-YEAR OLD DIVISION-AMATEUR FUTURITY

HOW TO KEEP THE TWO-OLD ELIGIBLE In order to make a colt, filly, or gelding eligible to show in the Two-Year Old Division of the Amateur Futurity, the following conditions must be complied with: (1) The colt, filly, or gelding must have been entered in the Weanling and Yearling Divisions of this Amateur Futurity and all conditions and requirements of those Divisions must have been fulfilled.

(2) One-time fee of \$50.00 must be paid to the Futurity on or before May 1st of the year the entry becomes a two-year old.

HOW SHOWN, The entries in this division shall be shown In Hand.

PRIZES

HOW THE PRIZES ARE DIVIDED In each division the winner will receive 30% of the prize fund of that division; second, 23%; third, 16%; fourth, 13%; fifth, 8%; sixth, 5%; seventh, 3%; eighth, 2%; ninth, \$200; and tenth, 200.

The nominator of the dam of the winning foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$100.00. The nominator of the dam of the second place foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$50.00.

The nominator of the sire of the winning foal of the Weanling Division will receive \$100.00, and the nominator of the sire of the second place foal in the Weanling Division will receive \$50.00.

VALUE OF THE PRIZE FUND The value of the Prize Fund of the Futurity each year shall be the total amount of money paid in fees, miscellaneous funds, and added donations less 10% administrative expenses. Each year the specific awards to the nominators of the dams and sires will be deducted before the division of the Prize Fund among the three regular divisions of the Futurity.

HOW PAID The Prize Fund shall be divided equally between the Weanling, Yearling, and Two-Year Old Divisions.

FEES

WHERE TO PAY FEES: Make checks payable to the American Saddlebred Horse Futurity of Indiana.

LIABILITY: No entry is liable for more than the amount paid in but there will be no return of payment. The right is reserved to reject any entry, and to debar any entry from competition for failure to comply with the conditions of the Futurity.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The use of artificial appliances or devices on weanlings and yearlings such as chains, shackles, rubber bands or blindfolds is prohibited on the grounds before or during a show, Smooth, round leather straps are allowed
2. Blinkers hoods with half-cups mounted in the vertical position so as to allow forward vision are allowed on weanlings and yearlings on the grounds before and during a show.
3. Weanlings and yearlings must show with uncut, unset tails; tail sets worn on the show grounds in preparation for the show are expressly prohibited.
4. The use of curb bits on weanlings and yearlings is prohibited.

ANY ENTRY WITH PROHIBITED EQUIPMENT MUST BE DISQUALIFIED FROM FURTHER COMPETITION AND SHALL FORFEIT

ALL ENTRY FEES AND WINNINGS.
